

<u>Year 3 – Autumn Term 2</u>

Curriculum Theme: Landscapes and Settlement



Landscapes and Settlement



Geography: Children will learn about the HS2 project and how it will impact on the environment and local communities. They will learn about the two sides of the arguments for and against the HS2 project. Pupils will also study the relationships between continents, countries and will be able to name some counties the HS2 project runs through.

<u>RE</u>: Pupils learn about how love and light are key themes within the festival of Christmas and these themes throughout the stories, songs and activities used.

<u>Science</u>: Pupils will learn about the diets of different animals, including humans. They will name the main purposes of the skeleton and they will name the bones in the body. They will also identify vertebrates, invertebrates and exoskeletons.

<u>Music</u>: The learning this term will focus on developing our Ukele knowledge, resulting in a performance on the 29th of November.

<u>PSHE</u>: The pupils will learn about respect for our similarities and difficulties.

English:

This term we will be exploring the books Charlie and the Chocolate Factory by Roald Dahl and Chocolate Cake by Michael Rosen. Through these texts, we will learn about and create a letter. We will also write a newspaper article, a narrative story and explore poetry.

In our grammar sessions, we will learn about pronouns to avoid repetition, using prepositions and using and punctuating direct speech. In addition, we will look at fronted adverbials. We will also continue to learn the Year 3 common exception words.

Maths:

We will begin to look at multiplication which will include multiplying by 3,4 and 8,and move on to dividing by the same amounts. We will identify this as repeated addition as well as representing it as an array. This will support us with learning.

We will also dip into our next topic of fractions and identify what this looks like pictorially and using resources.
