This Curriculum newsletter aims to give you an insight into what we will be learning this term.


Please talk to your child about what he/she is learning at school.

Our Topic

Our topic for the next two weeks is 'Dinosaurs'. We will be learning everything there is to know about these amazing creatures from the past! After that, we will start to explore the signs of spring, learning about new beginnings and getting ready for Easter!

We will continue to focus on applying our growing phonic knowledge in our reading and writing. In our writing lessons we will focus on writing simple labels and captions.

In mathematics we will be learning to share amounts and consolidate our knowledge of addition, subtraction, pattern and 3D shape.



Reading

Please read with your child regularly. Their books and book bags will need to be in every day. You may like to add a positive or helpful comment in their reading record, but please remember to sign and date in the comments space every time you read with your child. Reading books need to be returned to school every Friday, and will be changed on the following Monday. Children are expected to have read at least 3 times a week with an adult.
